

## Observers Plays of Interest—Week 1

With the first week of the season over, we have several plays to share with you.

CLIP #1—On this play we have a kickoff return for a touchdown. The Back Judge does a great job of reading the return and moves backwards very nicely to the goal line keeping good focus on the returner and the surrounding players. When the ballcarrier scores the Back Judge pivots and keeps an eye on the ballcarrier and everyone else while signaling touchdown.

CLIP #2—Here we have a quarterback scramble. The crew does a nice job of flowing with the action to maintain good coverage on the action.

CLIP #3—On this play we have a run down the Head Linesman's sideline. The Back Judge confirms that the runner did not set out of bounds with the Head Linesman and then they signal touchdown.

CLIP #4—This clip is about the new exception to the Intentional Grounding Rule. Is this play legal under the new exception??? The angle this is shot at makes determining if the passer had moved outside the Free Blocking Zone difficult, but watch it and see what you think—this clip will be shown twice.
